The SwapCycle event will allow Seneca Falls residents to give away usable but unwanted items to others instead of disposing of them into a landfill. Participation not only aids in waste reduction, but it is also a great cost saver during a time where so many of our residents are struggling to meet their basic needs.

How it works: Seneca Falls residents place items curbside. These items can be picked up by anyone who wishes to participate. Unclaimed items will be picked up by the Town of Seneca Falls on the designated Bulk Waste Pickup Day. Seneca Meadows will receive the bulk waste, free of charge to the Town of Seneca Falls.






Veteran Book Group

In honor of the **65th anniversary of the Seneca Falls Historical Society moving into the Becker Mansion**, Executive Director **Jonathan Monfiletto** will give a presentation titled **"The Beckers: The Family, Their Home, Their Help and How SFHS Fits Into Their Story"** during the SFHS's 64th Annual General Meeting and Dinner. He will share the history of Norman and Catherine Becker and their eight children, the mansion they moved into in the summer of 1891, the servants that helped the family take care of the household and property, and the historical society Florence Becker sold her home to in 1961.

Saturday, February 21st at the Lux Hotel and Conference Center, 2468 State Route 414 in Waterloo.

The event starts at 5 p.m. with hors d'oeuvres, and dinner begins at 6 p.m. with a buffet that includes sliced roast beef with au jus, herb encrusted cod, and eggplant parmesan. The business meeting takes place at 7 p.m. with the speaking presentation to follow. There are also a silent auction and a live auction.
