

Welcome to downtown, Riptide Coastal BBQ!

Riptide Coastal BBQ opened up shop at **106 Fall Street** in downtown Seneca Falls, right across from the Gould Hotel. It is known for its coastal-inspired slow-cooked BBQ, offering a wide range of flavors from the Caribbean to the Hawaiian islands to the Carolinas. Their menu features prime brisket, pulled pork, and tender chicken, along with housemade sauces and sides. They have received glowing reviews from customers for their gluten-free options and owner Greg Zellers' warm willingness to accommodate other dietary needs. Riptide Coastal BBQ recently added a Lil' Bites Platter option for lil' ones with lil' appetites: You can build your own lil' platter. Choose from their Carolina Pulled Pork, Caribbean Chicken, or Signature Brisket on either a slider roll or bed of pineapple rice. Then pick your own lil' side, any of their bagged chips, and also your own choice of BBQ sauce. All for only \$8. The Lil' Bites platter is a part of their regular menu, which is available on Sundays, Mondays, and Tuesdays from 11:30am until they sell out (or 3pm, whichever comes first). Come on in and enjoy hot, delicious meal in their cozy space or take your order to go! Don't want to get out of your car? No problem! You'll see Curbside Pickup available when you order online and they'll bring it out for you!


